Becas Chile Scholarships at the University of South Australia

As part of the Chilean Bicentennial Fund which provides Chilean students the opportunity to pursue higher degree studies in Australia, UniSA has signed an individual agreement with the Government of the Republic of Chile. UniSA will provide scholarship students with:

- 3 – 6 months English language tuition as required at our Centre for English Language (CELUSA)
- Overseas Student Health Cover for the duration of studies at UniSA
- 20% discount on total tuition fees for postgraduate study at the Masters or Doctorate level.
